2. Chief Executive Officer Glenn Pomeroy will introduce to the CEA Governing Board Dr. Hugh Cowan, General Manager, Reinsurance, Research and Education – New Zealand Earthquake Commission (EQC).
  - The area of Christchurch, New Zealand—the largest city on New Zealand’s South Island—suffered a devastating sequence of damaging earthquakes over a period of 15 months, starting with a 7.1M earthquake in September 2010. The ensuing 6.3M earthquake in February 2011 caused many injuries and deaths, and damaging quakes continued to occur until December 2011.
  - The EQC, private insurance companies, both the national and several local governments of New Zealand, and the entire population in and around Christchurch faced—and still face—many severe challenges in responding to and recovering from the earthquake sequence.
  - Dr. Cowan will provide EQC’s perspective on these events. He will also discuss the social and financial difficulties and opportunities inherent in the massive rebuilding process that is now in full swing throughout the Christchurch area, as well as the role of EQC in response, in rebuilding, and in planning to move forward to prepare for and respond to future catastrophic events throughout New Zealand.
