A PUBLIC MEETING OF THE ADVISORY PANEL TO THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE CALIFORNIA EARTHQUAKE AUTHORITY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Advisory Panel of the California Earthquake Authority (“CEA”) will conduct a **teleconference meeting**. Pursuant to California Insurance Code §10089.7(l), the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act applies generally to meetings of the Advisory Panel, and the meeting is open to the public—public participation, comments, and questions will be welcome for each agenda item. Pursuant to Insurance Code §10089.55, please take further notice that this meeting relates to the business of earthquake insurance conducted by CEA. All items are appropriate for action if the Advisory Panel wishes to take action. Agenda items may be taken out of order.

Pursuant to Governor Newsom’s Executive Order N-29-20, issued March 17, 2020, certain provisions of the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act are suspended or waived during the declared State of Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Consistent with the Executive Order, in order to promote and maximize social distancing and public health and safety, this meeting will be conducted by teleconference only. None of the locations from which Advisory Panel members will participate will be open to the public. All members of the public shall have the right to observe the meeting and offer comment at this public meeting as described in this Notice.

Members of the public should be prepared to complete their comments within approximately 3 minutes, but more or less time may be allotted by the Chair.
